SIGNS (Extra-Oral)

- 1 Facial Asymmetry Bilaterally
- 2 Short Lower Third of the Face
- 3 Chelitis
- 4 Abnormal Lip Posture
- 5 Deep Mentalis Crease
- 6 Dished-Out or Flat Labial Profile
- 7 Facial Edema
- 8 Mandibular Torticollis
- 9 Cervical Torticollis
- 10 Forward Head Posture (Lordosis)
- 11 Elongated Lower Face (Steep Mandibular Angle)
- 12 Speech Abnormalities

SIGNS (Intra-Oral)

- 1 Crowded Lower Anteriors
- 2 Wear of Lower Anterior Teeth
- 3 Lingual Inclination of Lower Anteriors
- 4 Lingual Inclination of Upper Anteriors (Div.2 Occlusion)
- 5 Bicuspid Drop Off
- 6 Depressed Curve of Spee
- 7 Lingually Tipped Lower Posteriors
- 8 Narrow Mandibular Arch
- 9 Narrow Maxillary Arch (High Palatal Vault)
- 10 Midline Discrepancy
- 11 Malrelated Dental Arches
- 12 Tooth Mobility
- 13 Flared Upper Anterior Teeth
- 14 Facets
- 15 Cervical Erosion (Abfractions)
- 16 Locked Upper Buccal Cusps
- 17 Fractured Cusps (Particularly CL 1&@ Non-Functional Cusps)
- 18 Chipped Anterior Teeth
- 19 Loss of Molars
- 20 Open Interproximal Contacts
- 21 Unexplained Gingival Inflammation
- 22 Crossbite
- 23 Anterior Open Bite
- 24 Anterior Tongue Thrust
- 25 Lateral Tongue Thrust
- 26 Scalloping of the Lateral Border of the Tongue
